

### **Coronavirus/Covid 19 Method Statement for Abrasive Wheel Train the Trainer Training**

Due to the coronavirus we have had to make significant changes in how we conduct abrasive wheel training on site at our customers premises.

Further to conducting training and RPE testing for the NHS during the coronavirus pandemic and following guidance from the Health and Safety Executive the following measures will help us to minimise the risk of contamination whilst still delivering the highest quality service.

**Only a maximum of 4 people to be in the room with the instructor at any time.**

The room provided must be large enough for the trainer plus 4 people to allow for social distancing and to allow for the setting up of the equipment.

Attendees will always be expected to practice safe social distancing during the training session. They must be in possession of the correct PPE/RPE.

Where social distancing cannot be maintained, due to the needs of the job, then face coverings (masks) will be used to minimise the risk and will be done for the shortest amount of time possible.

All masks for your staff need to be supplied by you, our instructors will bring their own masks and gloves with them.

**Anybody who is displaying symptoms of coronavirus or has been in contact with someone who is should not attend the training session.**

Anybody who is displaying symptoms will be turned away and not trained.

**On entry to the training room/work area attendees need to thoroughly clean their hands.**

Hand sanitizing facilities need to be provided by the customer for their own staff, our testers will bring their own sanitizer with them.

Good hand hygiene should always be practiced.

**Thorough cleaning and disinfecting of surfaces should take place before and during the training session.**

Desks, doors, toilets etc. should be thoroughly cleaned before arrival.

All the equipment that is needed for the training that is provided by us will be thoroughly cleaned before and after use.

We have spent the past few months working solely for the NHS and healthcare sector at hospitals, hospices, healthcare centres etc.

We have taken on board what these places have had to do to ensure that they can still function whilst stopping the spread of the virus and safeguarding the health and safety of everybody on their sites.
